

Tom Green, Crispin Glover signed to star in sci-fi comedy to film in Alberta

EDMONTON - Canadian comedian Tom Green and American actor Crispin Glover have been signed to star in a new science-fiction comedy film set to begin shooting in Alberta next month.

"Freezer Burn: the Invasion of Laxdale" tells the story of aliens from outer space disguised as Dutch oil company executives who buy a local grain silo and promise to create jobs for a failing farm town.

However, their secret plan is to use crop circles to heat up the temperature of the planet and turn Earth into a Club Med for extraterrestrials.

Producer Josh Miller said in a news release that the movie will be released in the summer of 2008.

Green has acted in features such as Freddy Got Fingered and Charlie's Angels while Glover has starred in Back to the Future and River's Edge.

The movie will be produced by Panacea Entertainment, a Canadian independent with such credits as Intern Academy, starring Dan Aykroyd and Viva Las Nowhere, starring James Caan.
