

## Shock comic to shoot film in Edmonton

Tom Green's latest starts filming next month

EDMONTON - Canadian-born comedian Tom Green will be in Edmonton for a month starting in early October to shoot a comedy called *Freezer Burn*.

*Freezer Burn* is about aliens disguised as Dutch oil company executives who buy a local farming company and promise to create jobs for the failing farming town. The aliens' goal is to use crop circles to heat up the earth and turn the planet into a Club Med for extraterrestrials.

Directed by Grant Harvey, the action comedy is targeted at a young male audience and also stars Crispin Glover from *Back to the Future* (1985). Green plays the reluctant town hero, and Glover plays the villainous alien leader.

"Edmonton, home of the hockey dynasty The Edmonton Oilers, The CFL team The Edmonton Eskimos, and also the largest shopping mall in the world," Green posted on his blog Sept. 22. "In the bread basket of North America. Surrounded by wheat fields, and a bunch of other cool stuff. I hope to have a good time staying in this amazing world class city, and to show all of you people here at the channel, this impressive town."

Famous for his outrageous brand of shock humour, Green is best known as the star of MTV's *The Tom Green Show*. He has also starred in feature films including *Charlie's Angels* (2000), *Road Trip* (2000) and *Freddy Got Fingered* (2001).

Green grew up in Ontario and now lives in Los Angeles, where he produces Internet TV talk show Tom Green Live! from his living room. The show airs nightly at 9 p.m. on [tomgreen.com](http://tomgreen.com), also known as "The Channel."
